- 1. How much of the world's oil is in the Middle East?
- 2. What body of water has the highest concentration of oil?
- 3. What is the significance of OPEC?
- 4. How does OPEC influence industrialized nations, like the USA?

- 1. *Evaluate* <u>unequal distribution of natural resources</u> in the Middle East. How might this affect people in terms of <u>what they do</u> and <u>where they live</u>?
- Create a diagram of the <u>rain shadow affect</u> and apply its significance in <u>the climates of the</u> <u>Middle East</u>. Use specific climatic terminology. *Give examples (draw)* the <u>three most significant</u> <u>climates</u> in the Middle East and *characterize* them in a few bullet points.
- 3. *Compare and contrast* the pros and cons of <u>desalinization</u>, <u>no irrigation</u>, <u>normal irrigation</u> and <u>drip irrigation</u> in terms of how they affect life in the Middle East. You may do 4 "mini paragraphs" if you prefer.
- 4. *Defend* the <u>positives and negatives</u> of building <u>hydroelectric dams</u> or not? Include specific <u>economic incentives</u> and <u>impact on human</u> and <u>physical geography</u>.
- Discuss the roles that <u>the Straits of Hormuz</u> and <u>the Suez Canal</u> play in international economies. Be sure to include the importance of major <u>surrounding countries</u> and <u>bodies of water</u>. Explain location and significances. *Hint think trade*
